Dear DA Courtnie Siess,

We are Janelle Babington and Penny Eims, animal welfare petitioners with AnimalVictory.org. We recently created a petition asking for 49-year-old Karen Jean Prichard to be held fully accountable for charges stemming from the discovery of a deplorable puppy mill operation at her Marlow, Oklahoma, property. It is our understanding that Prichard is not only facing charges for 113 counts of cruelty to animals, but also for the murder of 31-year-old Ashley Nicole Anderson. We, and over 12,600 of our supporters, hope to see Prichard receive the maximum punishment for each and every charge (please see linked petition for signatures and comments). Stephens County Humane Society board members commented on conditions found at the puppy mill operation - referring to the situation as "rancid." Board member Kelly Nelson said, "It was the worst thing I've ever seen in my life. We were called by the sheriff's department because of the number of animals and because they had no water, no food and no shelter."

Prichard caused unfathomable suffering, in addition to the death of a woman who worked at her property. We are hopeful that she will receive the maximum punishment allowable by law for each and every charge that she is facing.

We want to thank you for your hard work on this case, and we hope to hear back from your office with an update about court proceedings as soon as possible. We will reach out to you again if for someone reason we do not receive a response regarding the status of this important case.
