

Update 8/18/2022. Animal Victory has been in contact with the woman who rescued, and then rehomed the cat via Craigslist. The woman has told us that the cat was not "left with a friend," it was abandoned by owners who moved away and never came back. According to the woman, the cat was left in an apartment with a "drunk, abusive" man. The man allegedly threw the cat out into the parking lot, screaming "get this fucking thing out of my home." The woman who rehomed the cat tells Animal Victory that she was unable to keep the cat herself because of her work schedule and because she had pets of her own.
