





The facts establishing probable cause for arrest are that on December 29, 2024 at 15:00, in the county of Larimer, State of Colorado, at 252 W 2ND ST, LOVELAND, CO, 80537 the following activity occurred:

On 12-29-24 at approximately 1500 hours I responded to an animal cruelty call. The reporting party, CYNTHIA BOND told me that her daughters boy friend, KHALIN LOVELY 1-15-06 was caught on video abusing her kitten, DEXTER. BOND had suspected LOVELY of abusing the kitten due to the past injuries appearing when DEXTER was alone with LOVELY. BOND installed a hidden, motion activated camera in her living room that captured video of LOVELY hitting the cat in the face with an open right hand while holding it down to the ground by its neck. LOVELY is also seen carrying the cat by the neck. At one point KHALIN can be seen sitting on the kitten, applying his full weight on the animal while seated on a couch. After several seconds, KHALIN is seen leaning towards the kitten and moving his arms in a manner that would be consistent to more forceful handling of the kitten. During the several minute video the kitten is heard screaming in distress.

KHALIN was arrested at his mothers home later in the day.

Under Miranda KHALIN explained he had been accused of abusing DEXTER the kitten in recent times. KHALIN said he was scratched by DEXTER when he tried to pick him up. He said this was when they first got DEXTER. He said he picked DEXTER up using more gripping force than he should have and DEXTER sustained injuries from that incident. KHALIN said he was also scratched in this incident. KHALIN said the cat did not like males and felt that it had scratched him on purpose. After that instance he said DEXTER would run from him and hurt himself including when hot candle wax spilled on DEXTER and he was burned. KHALIN used the term "revenge" and "control" to describe the incident today that was caught on video. KHALIN said his life was out of control after he quit his job and had been arguing with his girlfriend. KHALIN expressed to me that he was suicidal and homicidal and that harming the cat was the only thing he felt in control over.
