ORDER REGARDING DETERMINATION OF INDIGENCY, PROBABLE CAUSE, AND PRETRIAL RELEASE

OFFENSES: AGGRAVATED CRUELTY TO ANIMALS

From all matters and facts before it, in accordance with Rules 8.1-8.5 and 9.1-9.6 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure, the Court duly finds:

- 1. First Appearance: The Defendant appeared before the Court and was advised of the nature of the charges, the right to remain silent and that anything s/he said could be used against him/her, that s/he had a right to counsel, that s/he had a right to communicate with counsel, family, or friends and that reasonable opportunity would be provided to do so.
2. Determination of Indigency: After consideration of the financial status of the Defendant, that the Defendant IS or IS NOT indigent and, if Indigent, that the Crittenden County Public Defender is appointed to represent him/her.
3. Right to Counsel: That the Defendant was represented by counsel and had adequate opportunity to confer with counsel.
4. Probable Cause: In consideration of the testimony provided to the Court, that probable cause to detain the Defendant pending further proceedings IS or IS NOT found.
5. Pre-trial Release: In consideration of the factors set forth in Rule 8.5 of the Arkansas Rules of Criminal Procedure, the Court finds that no other conditions will reasonably ensure the Defendant's appearance in court, and bond is set in this case in the amount of \$10,000 (Remain on Temp. Bond)
6. Additional Pre-trial Release Conditions: In addition to the above stated bond, the following restrictions/conditions are imposed:
a. The Defendant shall not use alcohol or other controlled substances unless as prescribed by a physician;
b. The Defendant shall not commit any offense punishable by incarceration;
c. The Defendant shall not venture outside of his/her home between the hours of 9:00pm and 6:00am;
d. The Defendant shall have no contact, communicate with, or harass;
e. The Defendant is hereby directed to appear in the Circuit Court of Crittenden County, Arkansas at 100 Court St., Marion, AR 72364, on the 18th day of MARCH, 2025 at 9:30am and is directed to maintain contact with his/her attorney and/or bail bondsman, if any, throughout the pendency of this case.
f. Other Conditions:

Failure to comply with any of the above conditions will subject the Defendant to having different or additional conditions imposed, which may include increased bail or having the pre-trial release revoked.
